Pianists of a superior level, less than 26 years old (limited to 12 maximum) who will have to present:

- First - a 30 minute recital including a Bach prelude and fugue, one classic or romantic piece, one 20th century piece plus an obligatory piece (Choice of Bruno Giner, “Deux ou trois chose d’elle....” from editions Dhalmann or Frederic Durieux, “Counting out time” from editions RAI Com)
- Second – the solo part of the Concerto Youngman of Mozart K.271: The competitors chosen by the jury will play the piece on September 3rd with a String Orchestra
